*Notice: All e-mail communications with the Pierce County Council may be subject to disclosure under the Public Records Act (Chapter 42.56 RCW) and should be **presumed to be public.***

- Comment directly from the proposal page (click "Comment on Legislation" on the far upper right)
- Comment electronically through the Council's [legislation database](#) or the Council's [on-line comment form](#).
- Attend a Council or Committee meeting where the proposal is on the agenda as an action item (see [Calendar](#) or the Council homepage), and speak to the proposal when open for testimony. The Chair will usually limit testimony to 3 minutes per person.
- Provide written comments at the Council or Committee meeting. *If possible, bring 10 copies of any written testimony and hand it to the Clerk for the meeting.*
- Provide written comments via postal mail or email. To be effective, these comments need to arrive for Council consideration before the final hearing.
- Call your [Councilmember](#) or the Committee Chair of the proposal you are commenting on.
